CORPORATE GAMES GROWTH

The lowa Corporate Games began in Des Moines in 2015, growing quickly. Through that success, ICG expanded to the Cedar Rapids/lowa City Corridor, and then further into the Quad Cities in 2021. Last year, we introduced the concept to the Cedar Valley, with further expansion planned for 2026. This summer, DMCG had 82 companies, and over 15,000 employees participate.

We are proud to feature Adaptive Sports lowa as our charity partner for 2026.

Adaptive Sports lowa (ASI) provides sports and recreation opportunities to lowans with physical disabilities. Programs offered in the Des Moines metro include: Beep Baseball, Wheelchair Basketball, and the only recognized Adaptive Cycling team on RAGBRAI.

COMPANY INVESTMENT

Entry fees are paid by each company and are based on the number of people employed in the Des Moines metro area. This is an all-inclusive fee and gives the company and its employees access to all of the Corporate Games events. The fee schedule for the 2026 Des Moines Corporate Games is as follows:

100 or less employees	\$1,600
101-300 employees	\$1,800
301-600 employees	\$2,000
601-1,000 employees	\$2,500
1,001-2,000 employe	es \$3,300
2,001-4,000 employe	es \$4,300
4,000 employees and	above \$4,800

Companies fewer than 75 employees are eligible to join with other small companies to split the fee and compete as one company/team. Companies that decide to combine cannot have their sum exceed 100 employees.
