

VOLUNTEERING CHALLENGE RULES

<u>Eligibility</u>

All participants must be regular employees (full or part-time), interns or retirees of companies registered for the Winter Corporate Games. This event is open to the public and participants are encouraged to volunteer in groups.

Volunteering Challenge Rules

Both volunteering challenges will be grouped in the same tally scoring.

Iowa Wild Volunteering Challenge

- 1. Companies will be given the opportunity for their employees to volunteer at Iowa Wild Games.
- 2. Companies can sign up by using the Sign-Up Genius <u>HERE</u>.
- 3. Tally points will be given out based on the number of employees who volunteer.
- 4. If a registered employee fails to show up for their volunteering shift, their company will lose 2 points per no show employee from their volunteer tracking total.
- 5. The Volunteering Challenge will run from December 1 March 1.

• Many Hands Thrift Market Volunteering Challenge

- 1. Companies will be given the opportunity for their employees to volunteer at Many Hands Thrift Markets in the Des Moines area.
- 2. To earn points, particpants will have to work a minimum of a 2-hour shift. Teams are encouraged to bring groups; however, individuals will be able to volunteer alone.
- 3. Each participant who completes a 2-hour shift will receive tally points that will be added to their company's total points in the Many Hands Thrift Market category of the tally points system that will be added to their company's total points towards the Winter Corporate Cup.
- 4. If a registered employee fails to show up for their volunteering shift, their company will lose 2 points per no show employee from their volunteer tracking total.
- 5. The Volunteering Challenge will run from December 1 March 1.

Winter Challenge Tally Tracking/Point Scoring

- There will be one virtual event (Virtual Fitness Class) and five in-person events (Volunteering, Fitness Walks, Cycling Tour Ride). The scoring for these events will go into the tally system.
- Points won't directly be scored from each specific event, but instead a "point tracking tally" will be kept for each and will be based on the total number of participants that check in and/or completed the given virtual event.
- The top six companies in each division will receive "tally tracking points." These points will used as a placement tracking mechanism and not be added to the DMCG Leaderboard.
