Registration for Burst Your Thirst will open on Monday, May 14, 2018.

Burst Your Thirst Information:

Companies will have multiple teams. Teams can be from 2-10 employees, and each company can have an unlimited number of teams. This challenge is great for all employees. It can be done right from your desk, and no time commitment outside the office is required. Your company's participation in the Des Moines Corporate Games allows this program to be provided at no cost to the employee.

Each team will have a team captain, but one captain can be responsible for multiple teams. It may make the most sense for the company administrator (or someone the administrator designates, such as a Sport Captain) to serve as team captain for all of the company teams.

The team captain can organize the teams in a way that makes the most sense for your company. The Des Moines Corporate Games is focused on overall company participation, so how you determine the company teams is up to you. You can use these teams to have an internal competition, or the focus can be entirely on points for the Des Moines Corporate Games.

Registration –The team captain will need the Group ID and Subsidy Code in order to complete the registration process. The company admin will receive this information by email the week of May 7. Contact the Des Moines Corporate Games if you need this information resent.

Note: Team captains must have each team member's name and email address at the time of team registration.

Once the team captain registers a team, a confirmation email will be sent from Live Healthy Iowa. All team members will receive a confirmation email with instructions for accessing their personal dashboard. This dashboard will be used to track water intake during the challenge.

Each participating employee will receive a water bottle from Live Healthy Iowa. **To aid in the delivery of the water bottles, please have all participating employees registered by May 29, 2018.** This will ensure that employees will receive their water bottles by the beginning of the challenge. **Starting May 30, 2018, any new entries will require the creation of a new team of at least two employees.** Adding employees to an existing team will incur a \$5.00 charge per addition that must be paid at the time of registration. Creating a new team will avoid these charges. Final registration deadline is June 18, 2018.
